Notice of Planning Permission in Principle application for the erection of a high quality high-voltage electricity cable manufacturing facility, including the construction of a 185m high extrusion tower with associated factories, research and testing laboratories, offices with associated stores, transport, access, parking and landscaping with on-site generation and electrical infrastructure and cable delivery system on land at Hunterston Port.
